- 8. Scholarship funds will only be awarded to the student's college or university account upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicants must be a resident of Bedford, Campbell, Franklin, Halifax, Henry or Pittsylvania County in Virginia.
- 2. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution in the year of the scholarship award.
- 3. Applicants must demonstrate positive-impact involvement in the complete sense consistent with capacity and circumstances and/or significant improvement/success in scholarship and community involvement, determined through letters of recommendation.



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Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendations from the applicant's choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individuals with significant knowledge of the applicant's experience and involvement.
- 3. An official and recent high school and/or college/university transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing rank.
- 4. Personal essay. In your essay, please answer the questions of what have you done to earn this award and what the effect this award will have on your future.
